Activiteiten

Het jaarprogramma ziet er in principe als volgt uit:

- Palmpaaszaterdag, 10-16 uur: Ronde Tafel Conferentie, waarbij kennisuitwisseling, opinievorming en stimulering van onderzoek centraal staan. Presentatie door een inleider, bespreking door toehoorders, conclusie; 4 tot 6 "kwesties" per keer.
- Mei, hele zaterdag : voorjaarsexcursie
- 21 juni, namiddag/avond : Midsummernight, informeel samenzijn op een, in tuinhistorisch aspect, interessante locatie, met daarover een korte inleiding.
- Oprichtingsdag (24 september), hele dag : najaarsexcursie
- 3e woensdagavond november: Mini-symposium, waarop nieuwe informatie wordt gescreenteerd door, meestal, 2 inleiders, waarna de mogelijkheid bestaat tot een uitgebreide discussieronde.

CASCADE legt zich bij alle activiteiten specifiek toe op de bestudering van de *geschiedenis* van de Nederlandse Tuinkunst.
